Time is critical for easy stain removal

> REMOVE SOIL & STAINS QUICKLY BEFORE THEY EMBED IN FIBRES








Always work toward the centre of the stain

> NEVER BRUSH IT OUTWARDS







When extracting, always vacuum area twice

- > REMOVE EXCESS MOISTURE THAT CAUSES
 POTENTIAL ODOURS
- > PREVENTS WATER STAINING OR DISCOLORIZING
- > LEAVES POTENTIAL SLIP HAZARDS WHEN WALKING OFF CARPETS





Always rinse carpet spotter with clean water immediately after stain removal

- **BLOT TO DRY**
- REMOVES ANY STICKY RESIDUE THAT WILL CAUSE RAPID RESOILING





Removal of stains / spills = 50% of problems
related to carpet care

Old stains may damage carpet





Always use light or white coloured towels for blotting or working stains

- > CARPET SPOT REMOVERS ARE AGGRESSIVE
 - > CAN PULL DYE FROM COLOURED CLOTHS INTO CARPET





Always test colour fastness before using spot remover

Coffee stains considered the most difficult stains to remove

> USUALLY HAVE SUGAR, MILK OR CREAM & COFFEE ITSELF

EACH REPRESENTS A DIFFERENT REMOVAL PROBLEM







You can never do enough vacuuming

> AROUND ENTRANCES



> ELEVATORS; WATER FOUNTAINS; RECEPTION







Use a "Professional" quality vacuum cleaner

> 2 MOTOR UPRIGHTS PROVIDE

THE BEST RESULTS







Mix carpet cleaning chemicals according to manufacturer's directions

> GLUG GLUG MIXING WON'T CLEAN ANY BETTER

> WILL LEAVE A RESIDUE THAT WILL CAUSE FASTER RESOILING





Water that is too hot may shrink carpeting

FOR 'STEAM CLEANING' USE WATER AT 120° – 180° F (48° - 82° C)





Add Winterinse to solution tank in winter to eliminate white sticky ice melter residue

2 oz./ gallon or 62 ml/ 4L for routine cleaning





Allow carpets to dry thoroughly before letting traffic on them

> USE AIR CIRCULATION FANS TO PROMOTE DRYING

> WILL CAUSE RESOILING TWICE AS FAST IF NOT FOLLOWED





Clean equipment thoroughly when done carpet care

- > RINSE, SPRAY OR WIPE WITH DISINFECTANT CLEANER
 - >Eliminate development of bacteria
- > RECOVERY TANKS & HOSES special attention
- > LEAVE LIDS OFF SOLUTION & RECOVERY TANKS
 - > eliminates odours caused by bacteria growth





Disinfectant cleaners used as carpet cleaners or spot removers will eliminate potential bacteria that effect indoor air quality

HEALTHY ENVIRONMENT





Use all available entrance matting during heavy snowfalls or moisture periods

> TREAT MATTING AS CARPET THAT REQUIRES EXTRA CARE

> REMOVE SOILS & DIRT FROM MATTING

NOT FROM WHOLE FACILITY





Start carpet care program by sweeping, shoveling, & maintaining outside areas

KEEP THE THINGS THAT CREATE PROBLEMS FOR YOUR CARPET OUT OF YOUR FACILITY





Set up a regular cleaning schedule for your carpet & follow it same as you do your hard floorcare program

- ➤ MONITOR & ADJUST PROGRAM TO MEET NEEDS OF YOUR FACILITY
- > TWO BIGGEST FACTORS
 - WEATHER & CHANGES IN TRAFFIC FLOW
